This anthology, edited by John Howard Reid, contains 90 poems by the late Margaret Havill Reid, including the title poem which won the Poem of the Year award from the Central Coast Poetry Society in 1993. After her death, the Margaret Reid Prize for Traditional Verse was established in her honor. Mandi was also a distinguished artist, who won many awards for her paintings and sculptures. Her poetry in this large-format book is illustrated with 70 of her famous black-and-white drawings. (Warning: 30 drawings contain surrealistic nudity. Although all the work has been publicly exhibited at leading art galleries, some people may feel these sketches are suitable only for adults). The 90 poems in this collection range from the politically oriented America and Dear Mr President to An Argument with God and A Headache for the Messiah; from recollections of the past in Requiem for a Ghost Town and The Coming of Wisdom to the humorous Brains and The Great Art Happening; from the descriptive Lizard and Yarramalong Valley (Chief Runner-Up for Poem of the Year 1994) to the personal Was It a Dream and Soundings from Other...
