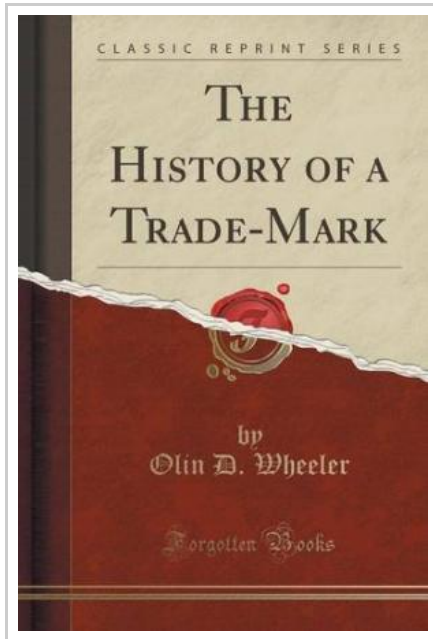




The History of a Trade-Mark (Classic Reprint) (Paperback)
