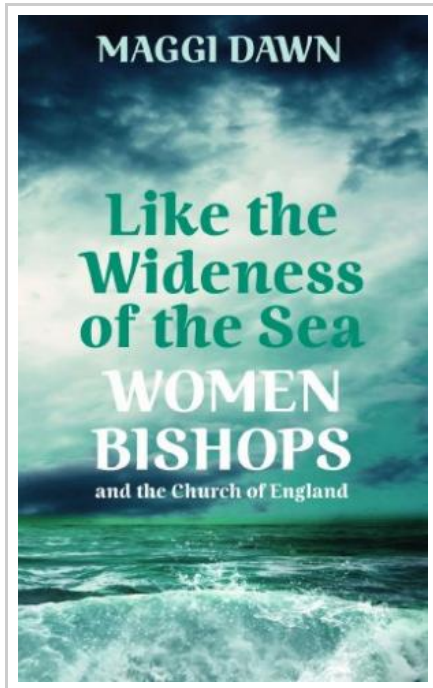




Like the Wideness of the Sea: Women Bishops and the Church of England
