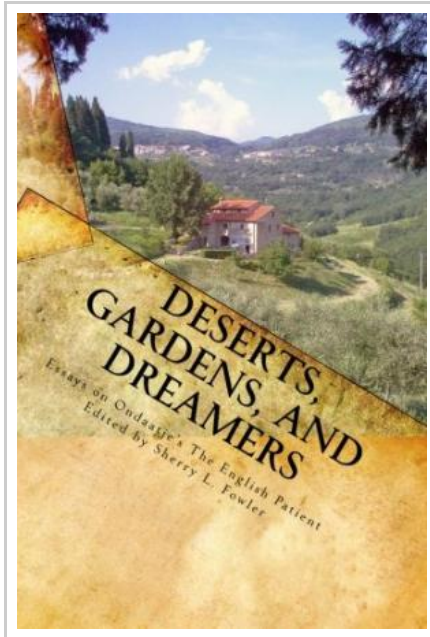




Deserts, Gardens, and Dreamers: Young Writers on Ondaatje's The English Patient (Paperback)
