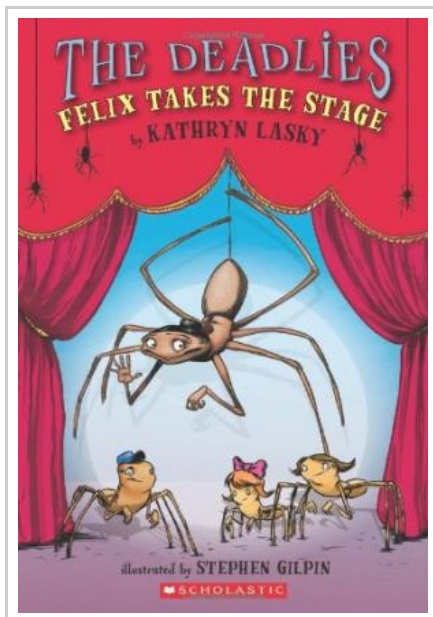




Felix Takes the Stage The Deadlies
