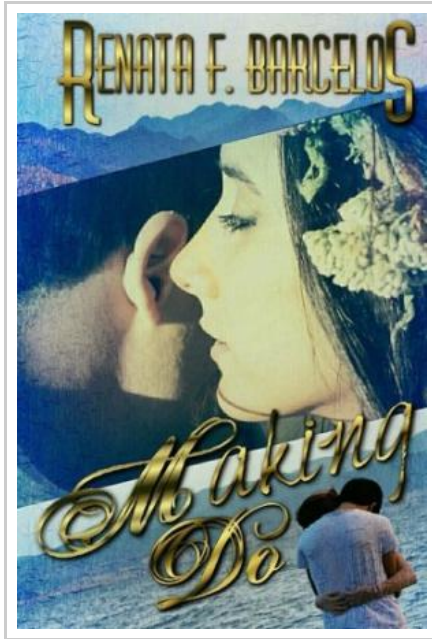




Making Do (Myself in Blue Book 2.5) (Paperback)
